#### ADULT CO-ED VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE

The Fairborn YMCA offers adult co-ed volleyball leagues for both recreational and competitive players. The Recreation Volleyball League is designed for beginners/novices looking to have fun playing in a low competitive environment, while the Competitive Volleyball League is set up for C or B level competition.

Please check above for league dates and fees. The YMCA will offer volleyball clinics for anyone in the Recreational League who wishes to better understand and learn volleyball.

Register your team at the front desk and a \$25 non-refundable deposit. Captains are responsible for collecting the remainder of the team fees and hand it in prior to the start of the season.

Teams will be asked to help set up and tear down nets, and will call their own violations (no referees). Each team will play multiple games (depending on number of teams) each night, using "Round Robin" play. Single elimination tournaments will end each season, as standings will be kept for seeding purposes.
